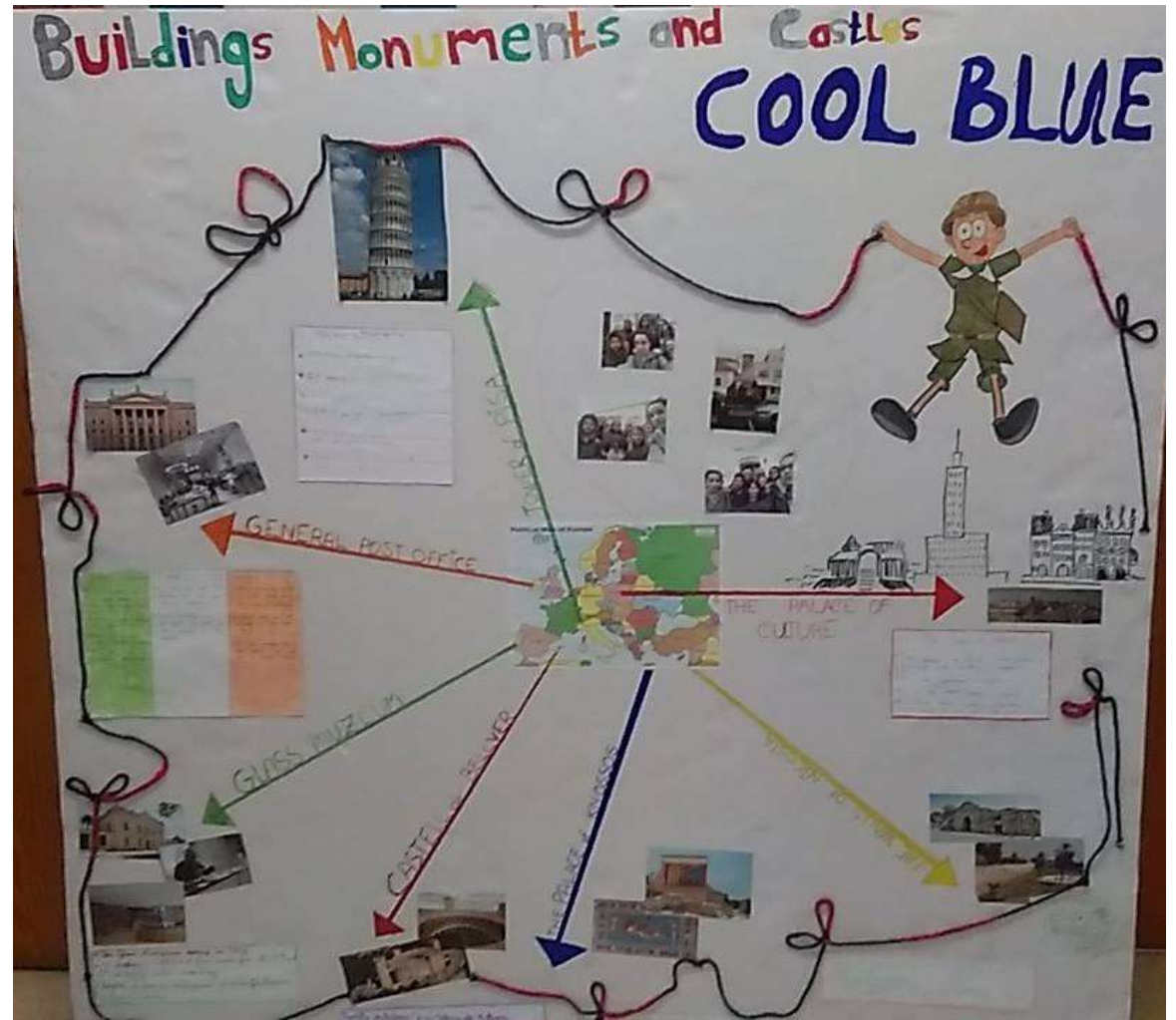














# COOL-GOAL The Story of Transport

### SPAIN

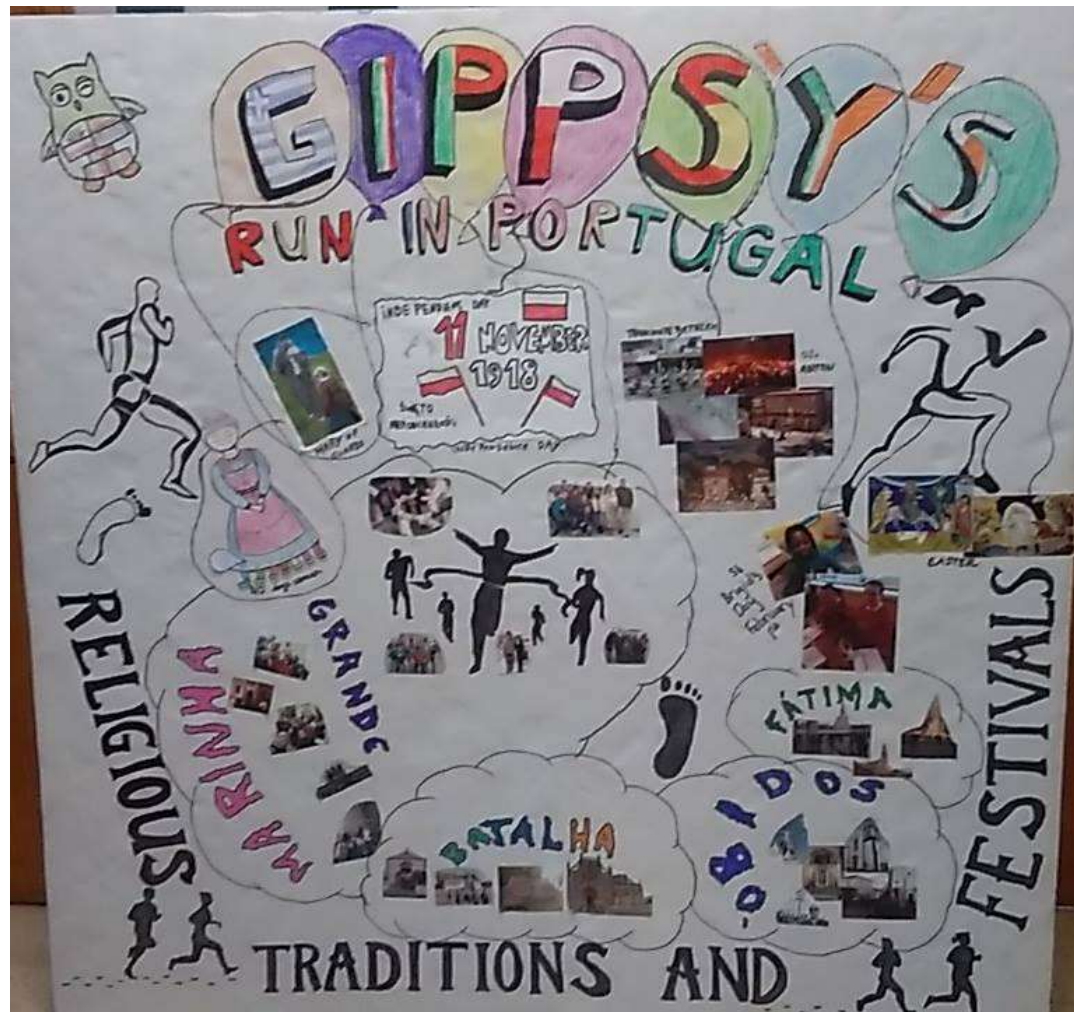
Plácido Domingo

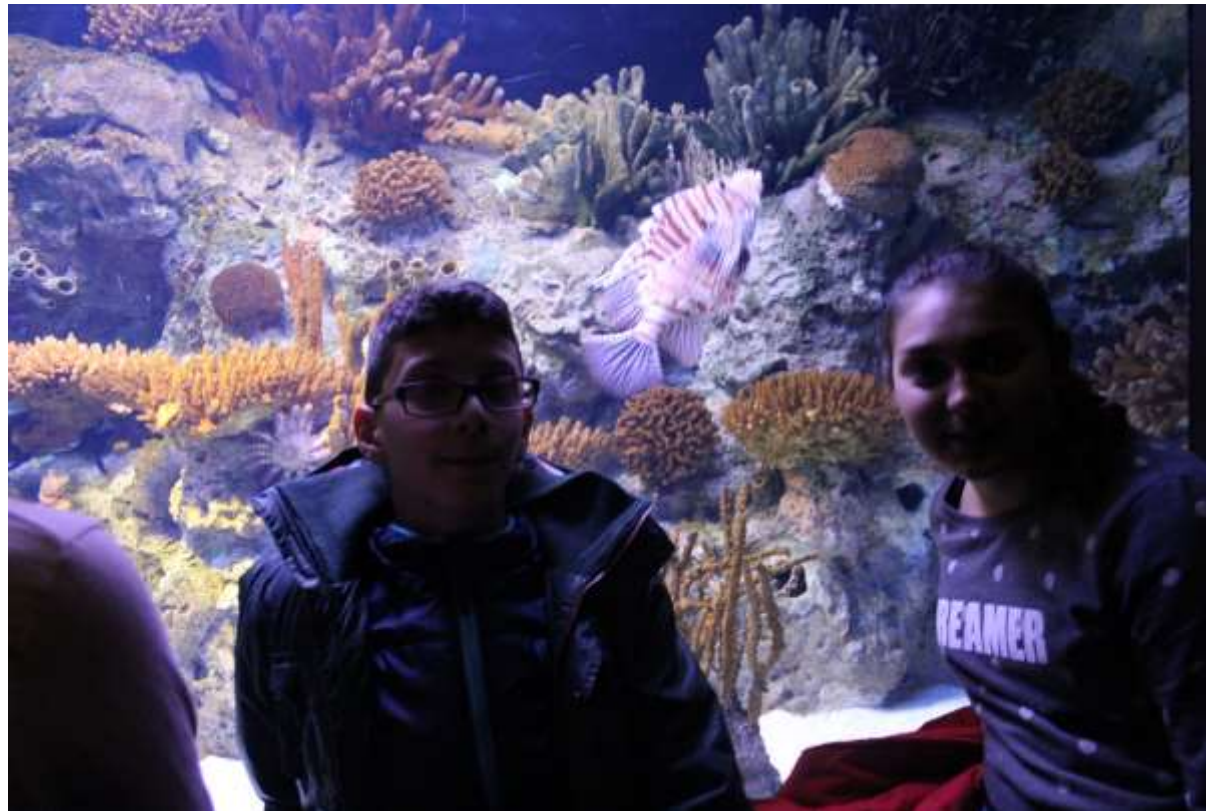

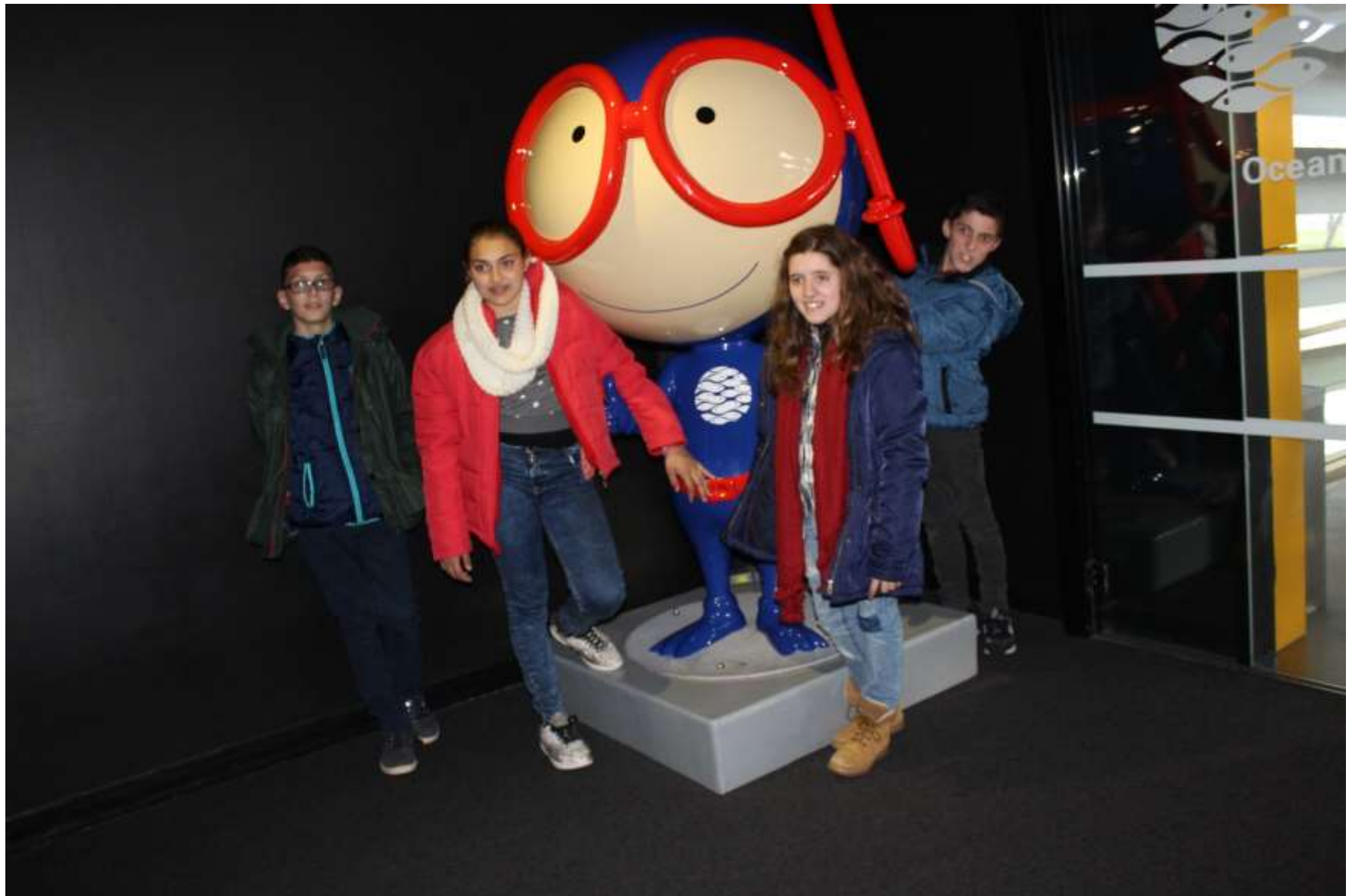
